Testament That is to say Principally and first of all I give &
recommend my Soul into the hands of God who gave it - and my
Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent
Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing
doubting but that at the general resurrection I shall receive
the same again by the mighty power of God And as touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me
with in this life After paying my just debts I give demise
and dispose of the same in the following manner and form
Item 1st I give and bequeath to my beloved Son Wm. D. Tomme
one Colt and one Yoke of Steers

Item 2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary
F. Tomme one Heifer & one feather Bed

Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Harriet
Curry one Bed

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my five youngest Children all of
my household furniture to be equally divided amongst them

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my four youngest Children for their
Support all the rest of my Estate both real and personal

Lastly I make Ordain and appoint my Son Robt. S. Tomme
Executor of this my last Will and Testament, disavowing and
Revoking all other former Wills and Testaments by me made
In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal A.D. 1855. July 2nd
