Reaffirm the conveyance made by me to my three sons to wit

By the deeds above mentioned and referred to the land mentioned
In said deeds that it is my Will and desire and has been for
many years that my three sons to wit William Henry Jones George
Milton Jones and John Wesley Jones should have the absolute
title to the land mentioned in the deed heretofore made by
Me to each of my said sons being the deeds above referred to
In this my last Will and Testament to them and their heirs and
to their own proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple
And that the same shall never be accounted for by the said

estate neither shall said land be charged with any debt or liability
due to my estate whatever

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Margarette

the said containing fifty acres more or less to have and to hold
said land to them and their said heirs forever in fee simple
I do hereby direct that my said daughter
Margarette shall take the following note due me and collect the same
and pay all my just debts to wit one note on J. O. Brock for \$54.⁰⁰
due the 1st 1883 one note on J. O. Brock for \$66.⁰⁰ due
the 1st 1884 one note on J. O. Brock for \$66.⁰⁰ due the
1st 1885 said note made payable to Beatty & Benson bear one note

on J. W. Jones for fifteen dollars due 1st of Nov 1883 in note on
J. W. Jones for fifteen dollars due Nov 1st 1884 one note on
J. W. Jones for \$26.00 due Dec. 25th 1883 one note on J. W. Jones
for \$16.00 due 25th of Dec 883 one note on J. W. Jones for fifty dollars due
Dec 25th 1884. The note and 25th due to be paid by him & collected for
them paid due and if any thing should be left after paying of same just
let it remain for the estate of said William, which I have to the
Out and expended for same I should need it.

Item Fourth, It is my Will and I do direct that my three sons to
W. L. Williams, Henry Jones, George W. Jones and John Wesley Jones.
And my daughter Lizzie Gray shall take charge of all my personal
property of every description I have and dispose of them to keep our
lives and benefit that each of them shall keep an account of
what part of my personal property he gets & the same shall go to
him as he best pay for writing and attending on me so long as I may
need it.

Item fifth, It is my Will and I do direct that my three sons
William Henry Jones George W. Jones and John Wesley Jones
And my daughter Lizzie Gray husband of my daughter Sarah
shall take charge of my home place the place where I
now live to keep it in repair & to have the rents and profits of
the same to go to them as fast as they shall want and expense
for writing and me so long as I remain in a helpless condition.

Item Sixth It is my Will and I do direct that I shall require
and be cared for and waited upon so long as I remain in
helpless condition my three sons William Henry Jones George
W. Jones and John Wesley Jones and every son in law
Gray either at my home, place or at their respective houses as
they be thought best that they are to be paid a reasonable
compensation for writing on and attending to me during my
confinement so long as I may remain in place and that the
personal property mentioned in the fourth of this my
last Will and Testament and the rents and profits of my
home place as referred to in Item fifth of this my last Will and
Testament does not pay them then some shall be a charge upon
my estate to be paid after my death out of what ever property I may
have left.

Item Seventh, It is my Will and I do direct that my Executors here
after named shall after my death sell my home place and to
pay off any just claims or debts that may be against my estate
and if there is any thing left it is to be equally divided between
all of my children and the representatives of children to wit
Isabella T. Robinson, Thomas Jasper Jones, Elizabeth Keating
Martha McLean William Henry Jones, Martha Kemper George William
Jones Henry Jones, Emma Holloway John Wesley Jones, George Bush
and Sarah T. Gray.

Item Eighth I hereby constituted and appoint my son William
Henry Jones and my son in law G. H. Holloway as Executors
My last Will and Testament. W. L. Williams Eighth day of June
