First I do hereby bequeath unto my wife Elisabeth Driskell and her four children all of my property both Real and Personal during the lifetime or widowhood of my said wife And in the event of her inter-marriage the said property to be sold and equally divided between her and my said children above mentioned

Second I do hereby appoint William M. Driskell of said State and County, Executor to this my said Will
