will and Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by
me. 1st Item I desire and direct, that my body be buried in a
decent and Christianlike manner

2nd Item I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my Executors hereinafter appointed as I am
unwilling my creditors should be delayed in their rights
especially as there is no necessity for delay

3rd Item I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Mary Ann
I Driver with whom I have lived in the strictest quiett for forty
three years the following lots or parcels of land lot of land
No 63 sixtytwo in the fifth district of Carroll County
and lots No sixty seven and ninety five both of the fifth
District of Carroll County and east half of lot No sixty eight
and west half of lot No sixty six and fifty Acres in the
north east corner of lot number sixty four all being in the
fifth district of Carroll County with all the rights accices and
appurtenances to said lots and parcels of land in any wise belong
ing free from all charges or limitation whatsoever during
her natural life and at her death the land to be sold and the proceeds
to be equally divided among the legates of said deceased

The land may be sold at any time when agreed upon by the
aforesaid Mary Ann I Driver and the Legates of John I
deceased And the said Mary Ann I Driver to take what stock
she thinks proper from any stock of Cows and Horses and
cattle hogs and sheep and then the balancer to be sold with
all the perishable property of my estate whenever the said
Mary Ann I Driver and the legates may think proper and the
proceeds to be equally divided among the said Legates

4th Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife for and

For my her natural life only any negro man Ned and his wife
 Peast and her two youngest Children Emily and Savannah
 and my negro man George and Rose a girl The balance of
 my negroes to be hired out or sold whichever the said Mary Ann
 Driver and the Legatus thinks best, and the proceeds equally
 divided among them And the negroes that I have given to my
 beloved Wife during her natural life At her death to be sold
 and the proceeds equally divided among the Legatus

5th Item I hereby constitute and appoint my said W. M. Driver and
 G. M. Driver my executors of this my last will and Testament
 John Driver
