natural life, also to take care of and support
my daughter Rhody & Stephens and when the
above obligation is fully complied with all
of the property of John Demoney shall be
the right of William M. Demoney John Demoney

containing 30 3/4 acres about seventy acres in
cultivation with all the right members and appur-
tenances to land in anywise belonging free from
all charges or limitation whatever, except for the
education and maintenance of my children during
her natural life or widowhood only. I also give
and bequeath to my beloved wife in the same
unreserved manner all my live stock and farming
implements used on and belonging to said plantation
of every description also my household and kitchen
furniture I also desire and direct that my executor
have full power to sell any part or all of my
land or personal property either for the
maintenance of my children or to reinvest in
