and memory do make this my last Will
and Testament.
Item the first;

I give bequeath and devise to
my wife Annie E. Faver the following property,
to wit: the undivided one third interest
in a certain party acre tract of land lying
and being in the County of Jefferson and
State of Alabama and near the City of Birmingham
the Same being the North West one fourth of the
South East one fourth Section (18) Eighteen
Township (17) Seventeen Range (2) two
in said last named State and County
the said above property having been inherited
from my half brother Moses A. Faver now
Deceased.

Item Second

I also give and bequeath to my
said wife Annie E. Faver the undivided one
half interest in two hundred and thirty
acres more or less of land the Same being
in the (8) Eight District of Meriwether County
State of Georgia the Same being inherited
from my mother

Item the third

I also give and bequeath to my
said wife Annie E. Favens one town lot of
land and the improvements thereon in the
town of Temple Barroll County Georgia
also the reserve one half mineral interest
in a certain lot of land containing forty
acres more or less sold to John Rollings
lying and being in the County of Paulding
State of Georgia the Same being inherited
from my father

Item the fourth

I also give and bequeath to
my said wife Annie E. Favens all my
personal property of every description
what ever it may be including
money notes household and kitchen
furniture and all the property that
I now have or may hereafter have
of every description

Item the fifth

I hereby constitute and appoint
my son Robert M. Favers executor of this my
last will and testament
