age but of sound mind and disposing memory. In saying that I must
shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both as regards
my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property
with which a kind providence has blessed me. I do therefore make this
my last will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all others by
me heretofore made

1st I desire and direct that my Body be buried in a decent & Christian
like manner suitable to my circumstances and Condition in life my
soul I Trust shall return to God who gave it, as I hope for salvation
through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord & savior Jesus Christ

2^d I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without
delay by my Executors herein after named and appointed

3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Almada Garr (270), two
hundred and seventy acres of land it being the Smith Martin Mill
Place in the 4th District in said County to have and to hold during
Widowhood. In the event she marries the said property to be equally
divided among my heirs. I also bequeath and devise to my dearly beloved
Wife Almada during her Widowhood the following named Slave,
one Woman named Jane and two Children and one Girl named Martha
& one Girl named Emeline one boy named Green one Girl named Victoria
if she should marry the said property to be equally divided between
my heirs, and that at the death of my beloved wife Almada the foregoing
property is to be divided equally between my heirs And if any of them
die without bodily heirs the property going to them shall be divided equal-
ly between my other heirs I also give and bequeath as above named to my
beloved wife all of my Stock and farming utensils. I hereby constitute
and appoint my wife Almada Garr my Executor of this my last &
Testament this 1st day of December 1864 R. W. Garr
