Sixthly, The remainder of the proceeds of the Sale of the land
I've decided as follows:
Seventhy, I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah T. Key and
her children one eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of
the sale of the land.
Eighty, I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Brice one
Eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of the sale of
the land.
Ninethy, I give and bequeath to my son Alexander Brice
one eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of the Sale
of the land.
Tenthly, I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary E. Johnson one
Eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of the Sale of the land.
Eleventhly, I give and bequeath to my daughter Chiffonier B. Suggins
one ~~and~~ eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of the
Sale of the land.
Twelfthly, I give and bequeath to my son Albert B. Brice one
Eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of the Sale of the
land.
Thirteenthly, I give and bequeath to my son Hamilton H. Brice
One eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of the Sale of the
Land.
Fourteenthly, I give and bequeath to my son Harry Brice one
Eighth of the remainder of the proceeds of the Sale of the
Land.
Fifteenthly, I give hereby constitute and appoint my son Albert B.
Brice and Gray Brice, Executors of this my last Will
& Testament, Which is to be executed at the death of my
Beloved Wife and myself.
