 to settle my worldly affairs while I have strength so to do make and publish this my last
 Will and Testament hereby revoking all wills by me made at any time heretofore
 and first I commit my soul to God who gave it, and may I desire to be buried at Bethlehem
 Church in said County & 11th Dist by my sons

1st I desire all my debts to be paid out of what I leave to my dear wife
 2nd I give and bequeath unto my grand son Thomas J. D. Hand Over hundred acres of land
 more or less south half of lot No (95) One hundred and ninety five in the ninth District
 of Carroll County Geo. If my grand son Thomas J. D. Hand should die without
 any heirs before he arrive at the age of twenty one years It shall come back to my sons
 John, Burton & Willis Hand And after he arrive at the age of twenty one years he has the
 right to do as he pleases with said land

3rd I give and bequeath unto my dear beloved wife Swanna Hand Three hundred acres of land
 more or less in the ninth District of Carroll County Geo lot No 201 two hundred and one and half
 lot number (202) two hundred, I also give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Fifty acres of
 land more or less in Heard County Ga known as the little place, and a negro boy by the
 name Jack dark complexion thirty six years old and I give and bequeath unto my
 beloved wife all the rest of my estate both real and personal and at her death
 all the above named property is to be equally divided between my three sons
 Burton H. Hand John H. Hand & Willis S. Hand & if either of my three sons
 Burton H. Hand John H. Hand & Willis S. Hand should die without an heir
 it shall be equally divided between the two that is left of my three sons
 above named or if two should die it shall all go to the one that is left
 of my three sons above named The reason that I have not given my son
 in Law E. M. Nolis anything in my Will, he has received his part of my estate
 the receipt of E. M. Nolis and my daughter Parry J. Nolis is attached to my
 will which will show that all is satisfied I hereby appoint & empower David
 W. Sims my Executor to my last will and Testament In witness whereof I
 the said Sherrod H. Hand to my last Will and Testament I have set
 my hand and seal this 27th day of April 1864
