The residue of my estate real and personal I want equally divided among all my children giving to the sons of my deceased son John S Hort that share that he John S Hort would be entitled if alive.

Likewise I make constitute and appoint my sons James M Hort and Charles S Hort to be executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal the 8th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy ~~ix~~ seven
