The residue of my estate real and personal I want equally divided among all my children giving to the sons of my deceased son John Hart that share that his father Hart would be entitled if alive.

Likewise I make constitute and appoint my sons James M Hart and Charles S Hart to be executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal the 9th day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy seven
