Sealed with our seals & dated this 3rd day of October 1833

The condition of the above obligation is such that if
the above bound Sheppard H. Williams Administrator
of the good Chattels rights & credits of Henry J. Williams
late of the State of Mississippi do so make & make a
true & perfect Inventory of all and singular the good lib-
erty & credits both real & personal of the said deceased which
have or shall come to the hands knowledge or power
of the said Sheppard H. Williams or into the hands
or possession of any other persons or persons for him & for
him so made do exhibit to the Court of Ordinary of said
County when he shall be thereto required and such good
Chattels & credits do well & truly Administer according to
and to make a just true account of his doings & doing
thereon when required by the Superior Court or ordinary
of said County and the rest of the good Chattels & credits
both real & personal which be found remaining out
account of the said Administration the same being just
allowed by the Court of ordinary of said County
