I Bernha Holland of said county and state being
 of sound and disposing mind, and memory do make
 this my last will and testament.

First I will that my soul return to God that gave it,
 and that my body be buried in a decent christian like
 manner - Second, As to my worldly estate, I will, give
 and bequeath as follows, to my son J. C. Holland my
 Heiress, to my two daughters, Sallie and Omega, I
 give all of the remainder of household and kitchen
 furniture, except one large feather bed, and the said
 Sallie and Omega to pay the sum of ten dollars to
 add to said feather bed, and that the said dollar be
 used in the purchase of material to make three beds
 including the material in said big bed mentioned which
 I desire shall be given to my three sons to wit, Willie
 Esther and Arthur, and that each of them shall
 have with their beds one fifth of all the bed clothing
 Third - I desire and direct that all of my stock
 wagon buggy farming and Mechanical tools to remain
 on my place for the use of my children, the
 Mechanical tools I give to my two sons, Esther
 & Arthur to be delivered to them at their majority.
 I further direct, that if my horse should die, that
 my executors should sell the buggy, or if the buggy should
 become useless, that he sell the horse, and use the
 proceeds thereof as he may see fit & proper, and
 the stock, and the increase thereof to be divided
 among the five children mentioned to wit Willie
 Esther Arthur Sallie and Omega as they become
 of age or marry share & share alike
 Fourth, I desire that my Executors collect the rents
 due, and apply the proceeds to the payment of
 the balance of the purchase money due on the
 land known as my clover, the balance of the produce
 to remain on the place for the use of the
 minor children.

Fifth - I will and bequeath to my son Willie
 30 acres of land off lot no 144 lying west of
 the clover also the Blacksmiths tools and a
 certain silver watch that formerly belonged to his
 father and that he receive the same at my
 death - Sixth - To my son in law William H
 Boatright, I will give and bequeath all the
 land where I now live, known as the clover
 together with all the appertinances therunto
 belonging in consideration of which the

said Boatright is to take care of maintain and educate my four minor children to wit Esther, Sallie and Omega, that is to give them not less than three months schooling each year year during their minority and when my two sons become of age the said Boatright is to give to each of them a horse bridle and saddle equal in value to one hundred dollars

Seventh, I will and desire that my executor cancel and deliver to my son-in-law L. P. (Buzard) a certain promissory note I hold against him for the sum of sixty-five dollars, all also I desire that my executor cancel and deliver to my son-in-law W. H. Boatright a certain promissory note I hold against him for the sum of sixty-five dollars all of which I give and bequeath to them

Eighth, I will and desire that as my son J. E. Holland has purchased of me fifty acres of land off lot No 142 in the 3^d Dist of said county lying east of the River and adjoins the lands of L. Holland and has paid all of the purchase money except twenty-seven dollars, that he apply said sum balance due, to payment of my just debts and if any over to me for the support of my minor daughter herein named and that said land shall be and remain the property of said J. E. Holland for all intents and purposes all though I had executed a deed thereto

Ninth, I desire & direct that my executor receive and dispose of the cotton raised this year by my children except four hundred pounds of lint to which my son Willie is entitled and to collect all other debts due me, not herein mentioned and apply the same to the payment of my just debts and the expenses of carrying into effect this my last will and testament

Tenth, And lastly, I constitute and appoint my beloved son J. E. Holland as my executor for the purpose therein named.
