I Hiram Sharp Sen being of sound mind & memory but feeble in health do make and constitute the following my last will and testament To wit

Item 1st

After the death of myself & my wife Sarah I give & bequeath all my personal effects to be equally divided amongst all my children & the heirs of those dead to be & go to their children living at my death or having lineal descendants

Item 2^d

I give & bequeath to my son George S Sharp one $\frac{1}{3}$ of the land on lot No 209. in the 5th District lying east of the road leading from Carrollton to Vanwert that is the north $\frac{1}{3}$ of said part of land as run off by me & divided from the part deeded by me to Sarah Hunter's children by a marked line running east & west from said road to the east line of said lot

Item 3^d

I give & bequeath to my son Hiram Sharp Jr the $\frac{1}{3}$ of the same parcel of land on the same lot lying east of said road that is the south $\frac{1}{3}$ of the said parcel of land as run off by me & divided ~~from~~ the $\frac{1}{3}$ deeded to Hunter's children by a marked line running from said road to the east line of said parcel of land so that the said Hiram Sharp Jr shall hold the south $\frac{1}{3}$ of the said parcel of land lying East of the Carrollton & Vanwert road. the said George Sharp holds the north $\frac{1}{3}$ of the same the middle $\frac{1}{3}$ of the same having already been disposed of to Sarah Hunter's children

Item 4th

I constitute & appoint my beloved sons George S Sharp & Hiram Sharp Jr my executors
