will and testament hereby revoking all others
heretofore made by me

1st I desire my body to
be buried in a christianlike manner suitable
to my circumstances and condition in life
my soul I trust will return to rest with God
who gave it as I hope for eternal salvation
through the merits and atonement of the bleas-
ed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ whose religion
I have professed and as I humbly trust enjoyed
for twenty years

2^d I desire and direct that all
my just debts be paid without delay by my exec-
utor hereafter appointed as I am unwilling that my
creditors should be delayed in their rights especially
as there is no necessity for delay

3^d I give be-
queath and devise to my beloved old father James
Barrow fifty dollars

4th I give bequeath and devise
to my beloved sister Frances Plott two hundred dollars

5th I give bequeath & devise to my beloved sister M. Ed-
Smith two hundred dollars

6th I give bequeath & devise to my beloved sister Sarah
Jane Smith two hundred dollars

7th I give bequeath & devise to my beloved sister Mor-
tuary Rust two hundred dollars

- 8th I give bequeath and devise to my beloved brother John
T Barrow deceased's daughter Eliza S Phillips and his
son James R Barrow one hundred dollars each
- 9th I give bequeath and devise to my beloved brother
William H Barrow two hundred dollars
- 10th I give bequeath and devise to the Baptist Church
of Bowdan Carroll County Ga of which I am a mem-
ber five hundred dollars to be used as the church
may direct
- 11th I give bequeath and devise to the M E Church of
Bowdan (White) Carroll County Ga fifty dollars
to be used as said church may direct
- 12th I give bequeath and devise to the Methodist
Protestant Church of Bowdan Carroll County
Ga fifty dollars to be used as said church
may direct
- 13th I give bequeath & devise to my beloved
son John William Barrow all the remainder
of whatever kind of my effects after complying
with the foregoing bequests. Now should my
son John William Barrow depart this life
before majority of 21 years old and without heirs
I will and bequeath that all of my effects then re-
maining shall be sold by the guardian of my said
son John William Barrow and equally divided between
my brothers and sisters or their heirs
- 14th Now to comply with the foregoing bequests I
desire that all my perishable property be sold by my
executor hereafter to be appointed as the law directs
all real estate to be held in the hands of the Guardian
of my son John William Barrow yet to be appointed
until my said son becomes of age to receive ac-
cording to law provided there is enough of my per-
ishable property and debts due me to comply with
the bequests heretofore made I desire said executor
to collect all demands due me as soon as due if pos-
sible and pay off said bequests and I further de-
sire that the guardian to be appointed for my son
John William Barrow shall use what is or may
be necessary of the proceeds of the real estate to keep
them in repair for the comfort of tenent and
benefits of said real estate and also my Will en-
tered known as a half interest in the Victory Mills
Carroll County Ga all of said property to be kept
up from the proceeds of the same until turned
over to my son John William Barrow unless
he should die before majority and without heirs
in that event all of said real estate to be
sold by my said said guardian and proceeds

divided according to bequeath do 13th
 15th I hereby appoint & constitute my beloved brother
 William H Borrow the Guardian of the person
 and property of my son John William Borrow
 And I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
 friend John H Word as the executor of this
 my last will and Testament
