sealed with our seals and dated this 4th day of November
1850

The cancellation of the above obligation is such that if
the above named Thomas Hanthey was this day appointed
Guardian of the person and property of Mary El Hanthey
Orphan child of William Hanthey and his acknowledging
if the same by his acceptance of said appointment and of
letters of Guardianship of this date shall not and jointly
maintain cloth and educate said Orphan according
to his circumstances and shall take good and lawful
care of his person and property according to the laws
of the state and shall severally make a just and true
return of all his acting and claiming him into the said
Court thus the obligation to be void that to remain
in full force in witness whereof we have hereunto
set our hands and seals the day and year above written
