 mind and disposing mind, do hereby make this my last will and Testament.

Item 1st

I give bequeath and devise to my wife Calista Reese all my real estate of every Character and description, the same being the place whereon I now live and consist by the deed made to me by James M. Blalock except the lot in front of said place, known now as the Noble Ford and all of which is now enclosed, in Cornwell County Georgia, far and during her natural life, and at her death to be divided equally among my heirs at law, and for this purpose I direct my Executor hereinafter named immediately after the death of my said wife to sell said property at public auction and the proceeds in which said sales are contributed, and divide the proceeds arising from said sale equally among my heirs aforesaid, after deducting legitimate expenses.

Item 2nd

In the event I should survive my wife aforesaid I direct that the above described property be equally divided among my heirs as above indicated.

Item 3rd

I hereby appoint Oscar Reese my Executor, and hold that he neither give bond or Security but only to make Annual Returns as required by law as in the case of Administrators.
