and I humbly trust enjoyed for many years

Thus second

I desire and direct all my just debts be paid
without delay by my executor, without excepting

Thus third

It is my will and desire to my beloved wife Mary C.
Johnson and to my son W. C. Johnson, my
eldest child, and to my son W. C. Johnson, my
second child, and to my son W. C. Johnson, my
third child, all of my estate heretofore made by me

furture including fire arms, sewing machines &c.
also plantation tools of every description, and provisions
sufficient for one years support; and for her lifetime
all that part of Lot of land (N 132) acres and hundred
and thirty two in the 11th North District Cassell County Cal.
lying on the east side of Jordan Creek, it being the
place where I now reside.

Third Article

All that remains of my property either personal,
movable or realty, to be equally divided amongst my
children, W. H. Johnson, William S. Johnson
Emanuel L. Lacy, W. F. Loomer, Josephine C. Jordan &c.
or their children where the parents are dead.

Fourth Article

I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Lucy
B. Johnson and E. H. Loomer (my son in law) my
executors and executor to carry out this my last
will and testament
