In the Name of God Amen. This 11th day of March in the
fourth year 1846 I John McComb of Carroll County Georgia being in a
perfect state of mind and memory thanks be to God for his mercies has being
affected in body and calling to mind the mortality of the body knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die. First I commend my soul to God who gave
it me and my body to the dust to be buried after a decent Christian manner
but believing that at the Great Resurrection morning I shall receive the
same body by the mighty power of God and as touching my worldly sub-
stance that it hath pleased to bestow on me in this life I have made
happily in the following manner vizt I first of time my property to the
payment of my last debts Secondly to my well beloved wife Mary McComb
first one hundred acres of land were on the head lands with the use and benefit
of all the lands and Great Mill whole the family continues together with
the use and benefit of my Negro Men turned so to with the household
and kitchen furniture with her lot she generally made use of also
she has cattle and sheep with her Negro Men & land & her dwelling and
an orchard but she made her 50 to 75 acres & birds part only to be
in common the Executor to make sale of the whole of the lands and my
wife to receive her proportionate share it shall stated in the balance of
property to be equally divided between my wife children named as
follows Maria McComb Nancy Elizabeth Frances Alexander Mary Emma
Martha Caroline Margaret Primitive Matthew & John Smith & Maria
Ann & Alexander to have and receive for the use & benefit the 1/10th part
each of the balance of my children does receive & those of most value
For Thomas having already received a horse & were for him to pay an
account out of their part till more will I have my Negro Girl Elizabeth
and Child Mary in the hands of Shil Harrison and Clayton Williams working
for the interest of James McComb to have now in possession for my debts
to pay of the debt and coming said girl Mary was there remain for the use
and benefit of the family till the family divided and be equally divided as
is stated & having two shares out of seven on a family of negroes in common

County North Carolina belonging to Michael Blomberg dec. now in the hands of his wife Barbara Blomberg for my Executor to sell my interest of said Negro and apply the same to my debt, having an interest also in the Estate of Brother Matthews McCorkle dec. I also desire for my Executor to receive the same and apply it to the use of my debts and all of my other property of every description to be equally divided after the payment of my just debts. I appoint Marcus McCorkle my son to be my sole and sole Executor and no other. Revoking Executor and former Wills and Testaments and this to be my last Will and Testament
