

In the name of God Amen I Joel Williams of the county of Carroll & state of Georgia being of sound mind and memory do make this my last will & testament revoking all others wills heretofore made by me I commit my soul to God who gave it my worldly estate I dispose of as follows.

Item 1st I give to my beloved wife Mary B. Williams one hundred one & 1/4 acres of the west half of lot number one hundred & three in the 5th district of Carroll County Georgia, ^{situated} her widowhood or her natural life & at her death said lot or parcel of land to be my son Joseph J. & the west half of lot no eighty nine except a small piece on the south side the said corner to be upon the west side of the mill pond near a spring then running south west to the road thence west along said road to where it comes to the to the line or opposite H. B. Chances land thence south along line to the south line thence east to the corner between me and J. Payers thence North along Payers line to the beginning corner containing some seventy acres more or less And two large bay mare mules waggon oven buggy drag boys sheep goats six blacksmith tools house hold and kitchen furniture plantation tools & all other things that I may forget I want my wife to have all the before mentioned property to use as her own during her natural life or during her widowhood & at her death said property to go to my heirs except the West half of land before decedded with any distinction. Item 2^d I want my interest in the Grist & Saw Mills it being half of said mill & that parcel of land which I except off of the south side of the west half of lot no eighty nine in the 5th district of Carroll County Georgia containing twenty acres more or less & my executor hereafter appointed to sell said mill & land to the best advantage either at public or private ^{sale} my still & stands my interest in the traveling Thrash one gray horse mule all to be sold to the best advantage & the proceeds of the sale to be equal ly divided amongst my wife and heirs.

Item 3^d And I hereby appoint my wife executrix to carry the foregoing will into effect.
