me do make this my last will and Testament

Item 1<sup>th</sup> I will that after my death my body be buried in a decent and  
Christian like manner becoming my condition in life and my soul I trust  
return to God who gave it

Item 2<sup>d</sup> I will that all my just debts be paid by my executor whom  
I shall hereafter appoint without delay out of my effects which may  
be on hand at my death.

Item 3<sup>d</sup> I will and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth I am  
all of my lands consisting of one hundred one some fourth acres  
of lot Number (42) with exceptions of two acres which is given to the  
M. E. Church South Eighty acres of lot No 23. fourteen acres of lot  
No 24 three acres of lot No 9 four acres of lot No 10. in all containing  
two hundred & five acres more or less together with all the appurtenances  
thereunto belonging to her own proper use benefit & benefit during  
her natural life or widowhood

Item 4. I also give and bequeath to my said Wife all my present  
property consisting of one mare one yoke of Oxen & wagon five Cows & Calves  
three hives four Sheep fifteen head of hogs all my farming & other tools

All my land hold that then furniture all my money notes or accounts all of my Corn  
 Cotton, oats, fodder pork or any other articles of forage or provisions to have and use  
 as she may think proper for the support of the family, or education of the Children  
 Item 5<sup>th</sup> I Will that after the death or second marriage of my said wife, that all  
 of my property be sold to highest bidder at public outcry and the proceeds equal  
 divided with and between my Children to wit James, Elizabeth, Rebecca C, Nancy & Mary  
 William S. Anderson S. Polly Ann, Mary C. an J. Ann an orphan of J. J. Lamy provided  
 that said James orphan shall only draw a Childs portion of the amount of the sale of  
 the land and shall not have any portion of the perishable property, and in case of second  
 marriage of my said wife she shall draw an equal part with my said Children  
 provided further that any property horses, hogs, Cows sheep money, furniture,  
 or any other articles of value which any of my said Children has or may hereafter  
 receive before the final division of all my said property shall be account  
 to them as so much of their part of my said estate already received

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I do hereby make ordain and appoint my said wife Elizabeth Lamy  
 Executrix and whosoever she may choose Executor of this my last Will & Testament  
 this 14<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year eighteen hundred & fifty six Signed in the
