the service of my Country when the dangers of dying are increased do make publish  
and declare this to be my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others  
Item 1<sup>st</sup> I Will and bequeath to my beloved wife Anna C. the land wherein I now  
live Alfred my negro man all my stock of Horses, Cows sheep & Hogs all  
farming utensils, House hold & kitchen furniture, to have and to hold during her  
natural life or widowhood & if she should marry again it is my will that  
all the above named property be sold and divided equally between my said wife  
and all my Children share and share alike during the widowhood of my wife this  
my desire that she use and control the aforesaid property as fully as I would my self  
if I were living & give off as she may think proper to any of my children who may  
Marry or leave her

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I shall my wife do without again marrying & will & bequeath to  
divide all the property named in the first item of my will to be sold  
and divided equally between them

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath to my said wife Mary a negro Woman to  
have and to hold to her and to her heirs and to dispose of as she may see  
proper either by Will date of otherwise

Item 4<sup>th</sup> State my will and desire that my wife & I. D. Thompson a citizen  
Executor & Executrix of this Will. Be and are sealed published & acknowledged  
in the presence of the undersigned they signing in the presence of each other  
and in the presence of the Testator.
