disposing memory, do make Ordain Constitute and publish
this my last will and Testament in manner & form following
to wit Item 1st I will and direct that that all my just debts
be paid

Item 2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Sarah
Ann Upchurch one negro boy named Alford about 17 years old
and a negro girl named Kirby about 8 years old for her
own proper use and use of her family during her natural life
and at her death to go to her children that she may now have
or that she may here after have by her present or any future
husband, and not to be subject during her life or at her death
to the debts of any of her said husband

Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Falasco
Jane Hollaway one negro boy named Miles about 19 years old
and one negro girl named Aunilia about 7 years old for her
own proper use and the use of her family during her natural
life and at her death to go to be vested in her children that
that she now has or that she may here after have by her present
or any future husband, and not to be subject during

Her life or at her death to the debts of any of her said husbands
 Item 4th I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Susan Catherine one negro
 boy named Jack about 15 years old. and one negro girl named Mary about
 10 years old for her own proper use & the use of her family during her natural
 life and at her death to go to & be vested in the children that she now has
 or may here after have by her present or any future husband & not to be
 subject during her life or at her death to the debts of any of her said husbands
 Item 5th I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Eleanor Matry one negro
 boy named Henry about 13 years old and one negro girl named Minny about
 11 years old lot of land Number 237 two hundred & twenty seven in the 11th Dist of
 Carroll County aforesaid containing 202 1/4 acres more or less. the said lot of
 land to be to her & her heirs forever in fee simple but the said two negroes to be
 for her own proper use and the use of her family during her natural life
 and at her death to go to & be vested in any child she that she may have by
 any future husband, and in default of children by her at her death then the said
 Negroes and their increase to go to & be vested in her brother & sister or their bodily
 heirs that is if she dies without Child or children or leaving representing
 of her children the property goes to brother & sister & their bodily heirs
 Item 6th I give and bequeath to my son Charles Matry one negro boy named
 James about 5 years old and one negro girl named Amanda about 3 years old
 which shall be to him and his heirs forever
 Item 7th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Catharine Matry the
 plantation whereon I now live No 255-256 in the 11th & 12th & 13th in the 9th
 Containing part of the numbers above. Two negroes viz Madison & Ann to have during
 her natural life but my son Charles to have the liberty to live on the plantation
 and have part of the same under her Authority, and the debts of my said
 wife the said plantation & negroes Madison & Ann & take care of them
 I also desire my said wife to keep the negro boy Jerry about 1 year
 old during her natural life and at her death to be sole by my executors
 and the proceeds equally divided between my five children
 which said plantation land & two negroes Madison & Ann after the
 death of my said wife Catharine to go to & be vested in my son Charles
 Matry forever
 Item 8th I desire that my wife Catharine shall out of the household &
 kitchen furniture notes stock and all other property not herein disposed
 of make the two children Charles & Eleanor equal with with the other
 children in the way of the documents that have been made in any life
 to those now married. And the balance to be disposed of by her as she may
 think proper after paying my just debts & all expences of the Administration
 Item 9 I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Catharine
 Matry and my beloved son Charles Matry my executors of this my
 last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this 7th day of November 1853. Branch M. Matry
