

Wiley Marlow's Will.

In the name of God, Amen!

I, Wiley Marlow, of the County of Carroll & State of Georgia, considering the uncertainty of life & the certainty of death, & being of sound mind & disposing memory, do make, declare & publish this my last will & Testament in manner & form following.

Item 1st. I give to my single daughter, Desta Ann Delora Marlow, fifty (50) acres of land in north east corner of lot number one hundred & sixty two, (162), in the eleventh (11) district of Carroll County, Georgia. One cow & calf to be selected by my said daughter; also, all my household & kitchen furniture & property, consisting of beds, bedding, bedsteads, side board, chairs, tables, chests, trunks, pot ware of all kinds & all other articles belonging to the household & kitchen.

Item 2nd. After taking from my estate, first, the portion above specially given off & set apart for my daughter Desta Ann Delora Marlow, then, I will and desire the residue & remainder of my estate, consisting of both real & personal property of all sorts & kinds, be equally divided among the balance of my children, that is to say, John A. Marlow, Eliza Ann Elizabeth Cheney, Adaline Liphams, James R. Marlow & Cintha Ann Bradfield.

Item 3rd. I hereby nominate & appoint George A. Bonner my executor, to carry out this my last will & testament. I hereby revoke all other wills by me made. This fifth day of December, 1880.
