make a disposition of the property with which a kind
providence has blessed me I do therefore make this my
last will and testament hereby revoking and annul-
ling all others by me heretofore made.

First I desire and direct that my body be buried in a de-
cent and christianslike manner suitable to my cir-
cumstances and conditions in life my soul I trust will
return to rest with God who gave it as I hope for salva-
tion through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord
and Savior Jesus Christ Second I desire and direct
that my just debts be paid without delay by my executors
herein after named and appointed Mary M. Chance.

Thirdly I give bequeath and devise to my beloved niece
Mary M. Chance one hundred acres of lot of land number
ninety in the fifth district of said County of Carroll with
all the rights members and appurtenances to said tract
of land in anywise belonging free from all charges or
limitations whatever to her own proper use benefit and
behalf forever with full power to dispose of the same by
will or otherwise as she may deem proper I also give and
bequeath to my said beloved niece Mary Chance all my
personal effects of every kind including furniture
utensils stock of every kind money and solvent debts
of which I may die seized and possessed over and above
what may be necessary to pay my just debts and de-
lay the necessary expenses of my burial as specified
in item first of this my last will and testament.
Fourth I hereby constitute and appoint my friend
Mary M. Chance Executor of this my last will and testa-
ment This 16th March 1870
