house now stands. Also Serrena and Cobert two slaves with all the house hold and kitchen
furniture which furniture is to be equally divided between her and the three youngest daughters now
in the family with us Also two mules and all the farming implements belonging to the farm
all the above for her use and benefit during her lifetime or widowhood. At the expiration
of life or widowhood the slave is to be sold and the proceeds of sale to be equally divided
among all the heirs. I bequeath to Elizabeth A McAllister, Sarah McAllister & Martha L.
McAllister one year's care & clothing before any division of the estate I bequeath also to my wife
three Cows and Calves the flock of Sheep and the Stock of Hogs. The fifty acres
of land and other property bequeathed to my wife not otherwise disposed of
the corner of my son Malcom McAllister at the death of the widow all the balance of my
land & estate may be divided equally among all my children except M. M. McAllister
Leave here which are as follows Nancy A Kinney William M. McAllister Mary A.
Howard & A. McAllister Isabella Carroll, daughter of McAllister, Barbara Christian
Sarah McAllister & Martha L. McAllister.

I do hereby appoint my son A. A. McAllister my executor this my last Will and
Testament the day and date above written interlined before signing
