 house now stands. Also Servants and Robert two Slaves with all the house hold and Kitchen
 furniture which furniture is to be equally divided between her and the three youngest daughters now
 in the family with us Also two mules and all the farming implements belonging to the farm
 all the above for her use and benefit during her lifetime or widowhood. At the expiration
 of life or widowhood the slave is to be sold and the proceeds of sale to be equally divided
 among all the heirs, I bequeath to Elizabeth McAllister Sarah McAllister & Martha L
 McAllister one yoke of oxen before any division of the Estate I bequeath also to my wife
 three Cows and Calves the flock of Sheep and the Stock of Hogs, the fifty acres
 of land and other property bequeath them to my wife not otherwise disposed of
 to become of my son Malcolm McAllister at the death of the widow all the balance of my
 landed estate may be divided equally among all my children except M. McAllister
 Lawful heirs which are as follows Nancy A Kinney William W. McAllister Mary H.
 Howard A. McAllister Isabella Cornell, Elizabeth McAllister, Barbara C. Fisher
 Sarah McAllister & Martha L. McAllister.
