 lands in Carroll be the last thing sold to pay my debts and
 Especially lot (No 44) Fortyfour in the (6th) Sixth District of said
 County of Carroll 3^{dly} I give and bequeath to my dear wife Jane
 during her lifetime The property after paying my debts both Real
 and Personal I leave to my dear wife for the purpose of raising and
 Educating my children to make them equal in Education if
 Possible and after they are all of age if my dear wife feels she can
 spare any property if it can be done by legal difference so it
 can be equally divided between my children Except my home
 place It being on lot (No 44) Fortyfour in the Sixth (6th)
 District of said County of Carroll and State aforesaid which
 home place I give and bequeath to my three sons to be divided
 Equally among ^{between} William Arthur Hugh after the death of their
 Said mother the Remainder of my Said Property I leave to
 be equally divided between all of my children after the death of
 my dear wife to wit William Arthur & Hugh and Esther C &
 Susan M & Cynthia and Virginia. As I have given to my
 Daughter Esther C a Horse and cart of the value of Sixty dollars I
 desire that my dear wife Jane shall so manage said Farm
 and Estate to give to each of the above named children as they
 become of age or shall marry off a Horse and cart of the like value
 and lastly I appoint my dear wife Jane and my son
 Wm to Act as my Executors to carry out this my last will and
 Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my name in the presence of the witnesses
