and in the Fifty second year of my age and feeling sound in mind  
Knowing that I have not long to stay in this troublous world deem it  
right and proper both as respects my family and myself That I  
shall make a disposition by will of what little property It has pleased  
God to bless me with Therefore this is my last Will and Testament  
First after my death I desire that my body be buried in a plain  
Christian like manner may soul I trust shall return to rest  
with God who gave it I also I desire that all my just debts be  
paid by my Executor hereinafter appointed I desire that my  
lands in Carroll be the last thing sold to pay my debts and  
Especially lot (No 44) Port Royal in the 6th District of said  
County of Carroll fully & give and bequeath to my dear wife Jane  
during her lifetime The property after paying my debts both Real  
and Personal I leave to my dear wife for the purpose of raising and  
Educating my children to make them equal in Education if  
possible and after they are all of age if my dear wife feels she can  
Spare any property if it can be done by legal sufficiente so it  
can be equally divided between my children Except my house  
place It being on lot (No 44) Port Royal in the 6th (6th)  
District of Said County of Carroll and State aforesaid which  
houseplace I give and bequeath to my three Sons to be divided  
Equally among them William Arthur & Henry after the death of their  
Said mother the remainder of my Said Property I leave to  
be equally divided between all of my children after the death of  
my dear wife to wit William Arthur & his wife and Esther to &  
Cesaria M & Signaria and Virginia As I have given to my  
Daughter Esther a Horse beast of the value of Sixty dollars I  
desire that my dear wife Jane shall so manage said money  
and estate to give to each of the above named children as they  
become of age or shall marry off a Horse beast of the like value  
and lastly I appoint my dear wife Jane and my son  
John to Act as my Executrix to carry out this my last will and  
Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and affixed my seal in the presence of the witnesses  
hereunto subscribed This fifth day of February 1863
