Ordain publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament
That is to say first after all my lawful debts are paid &
discharged the residue of my real estate I will and bequeath
unto my sons James E. Mark and Marion W. Mark consisting
of lot of land (81) eighty one and one acre off of lot no (82)
Eighty two all lying in the fourth District of Carroll County &
Containing (2034) Two hundred three and one half acres more or less
to have and to hold the above described land until their mother's
death upon the following Conditions, that the said James E.
Mark and Marion W. Mark shall faithfully support and
discharge their duty in all respects towards their mother
Elizabeth Mark for and during her lifetime and shall
support and keep their sisters Lucinda J. Mark and
Louisa W. Mark until their mother's death then the personal
Property to be divided as follows unless they marry then
the division to take place at their marriage that is to receive
one Bed and one Cow & should there not be a Cow apiece
for each one then the one falling short shall have the equal
part in money or other property. At their mother's death
all the balance of the property not mentioned above is to be
sold & and the money equally divided among my daughters
named in the Will viz. Lucinda J. & Louisa W. Mark

a mule which I wish my son Marian W. Mark to have, Likewise I make constitute and appoint my two sons James E. Mark and Marian W. Mark to be executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made I Witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal this 28th day of Novr 1867.
