That all my just debts be paid Third with respect to my worldly Estate I give bequeath and dispose of it in the following manner to wit: First I give and bequeath to my darling dearly beloved wife Margaret Watson my Tract of Land known as Lot No Sixty three in the third district of Carroll now Campbell with all the improvements there on and the said property and improvements shall be to her own proper use and benefit with my house hold and kitchen furniture which I will she shall hold during her natural Life or widowhood Second I desire that my sons Peter and Joseph. Stay on the Premises and make and have all they can after paying all family Expenses provided they or either of them will do so. Third I desire that Peter shall have the advantage on said place after supporting my wife and beloved daughter Mary Ann. Fourth I will that my Colored Woman Biddy have a home as long as she will stay with my wife and care for her as she has done before. Fifth I will that my beloved daughter Mary Ann have my my negro Child Gray provided she is concidered property And finally after my Wifes death that all my property both Real and personal be Equally divided betwixen the lawful Heirs of my body In Testimony whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the day and year above written Signed Sealed published
