publish this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking
all wills at any time heretofore made. - And first after
my demise I desire that my body shall be buried in a
decent and respectable manner. - And my worldly
estate at dispose of as follows.

Item 1st - I will that all my just debts shall be paid.
Item 2nd - I will that my debts that my estate both
real and personal shall remain together and undivided
during the lifetime of my wife Mary A. Neal for her
support and maintenance.

Item 3rd - I will that my son John A. Neal shall live over the
Mary A. Neal during his life time, with my wife
and have all the profits arising from whicht, - except a good
support and maintenance for my wife Mary A. Neal, which
I will they shall have.

Item 4th - After the death of my wife Mary A. Neal I
will that my estate then remaining both real & personal
shall be equally divided amongst all my lawful heirs and
lawful issue, with the exception of those that have
left their shares or claims of my estate to my son
John A. Neal.

Item 5th - I will that my son John A. Neal shall
be my executor to manage my estate according to this
will and Testament. - And that he shall not be bound to give bond and
security as is usual in cases of Executors managing
testate estates, unless he chooses so to do.
