

State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen! I Nathan

being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and being
desirous of settling my worldly affairs while I have time and
strength to do so, do make and Publish this my last Will
and Testament hereby revoking all wills heretofore by me
at any time made.

Item first. At my death I hereby give to my Wife
Elizabeth Martin all my Property both Real and Personal
during her lifetime with the privilege of selling or disposing
of such portions of the Personal property as she may think
with the advice of my Executor whom I will hereinafter
Name, to be to the Interest of herself or the Estate, with
the Express understanding That when any of said Personalty
is sold by said Executor he shall put the money arising
from such sale out at Interest so that it may not
be wasted but be a part of the Estate.

Item Second - That at the death of my said Wife Elizabeth
Martin all of said property remaining to be sold and the
money arising therefrom to be equally divided between my
Children Namely William B Martin, John P Ma
Ruben T Martin and Milly A M Hawkins.

Item Third - I do hereby appoint my son John P Martin
of the County of Cobb and said State Executor of this my last will
and Testament.
