differently from what the law has provided do make and Ordain this my
last Will and Testament in manner and form that is to say
1st I willingly resign my body to the dust from whence it came to be
buried in a plain decent manner at the discretion of my wife and my
soul into the hands of God who gave it not dreading but it will
receive a just reward

2nd I wish all my Just debt, and funeral Expenses paid out of my
Estate if there is sufficient to do it

3^d Whatever is left after paying the above I wish my beloved wife
Mary M^rke to have, my land, negroes, papers, ready money Stock and
every thing that I may die possessed of to have and to hold the same
clear of any other person whatever and to dispose of it or any part of
it as she thinks proper just as if she had never been married. Also at
her death to dispose of it as she thinks proper, and I hereby make
and ordain my beloved wife Mary M^rke Executrix of this my last
Will and Testament in virtue whereof I the said Richard Wood
M^rke have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand & seal this 6th
of November A.D. 1864
