addition to what has already been given, an equal part
in the division of my property.

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my Son Moses Richardson Russell
in addition to what has already been given, an equal part
in the division of my property.

- Item 5th } I give and bequeath to my Son James Harris Russell
in addition to what has already been given Three hundred
Dollars and an equal part in the division of my property.
- Item 6th } I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah Francis
Christopher, daughter of my Son Calvin Augustus Russell
now deceased, the sum of Five Dollars.
- Item 7th } I give and bequeath to my Grand Son Marshal Emily
Russell, Son Calvin Augustus Russell now deceased the
sum of Five Dollars.
- Item 8th } I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Calvin Augustus
Russell, daughter of Calvin Augustus Russell now deceased
the sum of Five Dollars.

an equal part in the division of my property.
