 this my last will and testament. I desire that my body
 be buried in a decent and christian like manner according
 to my circumstances in life. I also desire that after
 my decease that all my just debts be paid as soon as prac-
 tical by the person or persons who may have control of my
 effects. It is my desire that all my property remaining
 both real and personal be kept together in the possession of
 my beloved wife Ruth T Brown to be made use of in the
 best manner she can for the support and education of all
 my children during her widowhood. But if it should be
 her pleasure to marry again then and in that case, my
 desire is that all the property both real and personal be
 as equally divided into two parts as possible by persons ap-
 pointed by the inferior Court of the County and that one
 half be given to my wife Ruth T Brown to have and to hold
 as her own forever in fee simple. And that the other half
 be equally divided amongst all my children.

And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my
 wife Ruth T Brown the sole Executrix to this my last will
 and testament.
