

In the name of God Amen,  
County of <sup>3d</sup> I. Sarah Pitts of the County & State  
aforesaid, being weak in body  
but of sound mind despoiling mind & memory  
do make and publish the following as my last  
Will & Testament, to wit,-

Item 1st. I give, bequeath & devise unto my children  
namely, Wallerine H. Joseph C. Eli, & John H. Benson  
& Margaret T. now the wife of Thos J. Boggs  
all of my Negro property, to wit, Abby Brown  
about fifty years old - Lucy a negro woman  
about thirty years old - Peter a negro man  
about twenty three years old - Amanda a  
Negro girl about sixteen years old, George  
a negro boy about thirteen years old, Henry  
a Negro boy about nine years old - Andy a  
boy about five years old - Which Negroes they  
are to take possession of after my death, and  
divide them equally according to their  
value, & among themselves, as they may  
think proper best - The above named  
interest that is given to Margaret H. Adesce  
to go to her during her natural life & then  
to her children free from all liabilities, on  
account of her husband's debts or contracts  
now or hereafter, but the use & control for  
her and her children's benefit to have  
as trustee for them -

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my  
daughter Margaret H. the wife of  
Thos J. Boggs the following other property  
to wit, all my house hold & kitchen furniture  
beds & bedding of every description, with the ex-  
ception of one bed & bedding to go with it, which  
I leave to my husband Laban Pitts.

Item 3rd. I give and bequeath to my husband  
Laban Pitts all of my stock of cattle, hags & horses  
of every description

Item 4th. I give and bequeath to my aforesaid  
children all the property that may be coming  
to me if I should be succeeded in a law suit  
between myself & Thomas Thrower now pending  
in Spaulding Superior Court from said suit  
to be equally divided between them in the same  
manner as the property given in the first item  
of this will & the part going to my daughter  
Margaret to be limited in the same manner  
as that in the 1st Item -

Sheddy appoint my son Joseph C. Benson my  
Executor to this Will to distribute the same by  
dividing it into the three parts named  
without expense or litter, & then cutting

The foregoing was declared & published to us as the  
last Will & Testament of Sarah Pitts, while she signed  
sealed as such in our presence, & which each one of  
us has sign'd at her request in her presence & the  
presence of each other. Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> 1854
