 ance from Mrs Martha Horn to myself,
 wherein is a full description of said
 land, all of which land is in 6th Dist.
 of said State & Co.

Item 2nd

I also give, bequeath and devise
 to my said husband as aforesaid all stock
 and personal property of every description
 all of which property both real and
 personal, I give to my said husband
 free from all charge whatever to
 his own proper use benefit and behoof
 during his natural life or so long as
 he remains unmarried after my death
 the same, at the death or marriage of
 my said husband, to be divided between
 my children to-wit J. A. Smith, Martha
 J. Horn, Nancy E. Smith, L. W. Smith before
 Mrs. E. Smith, W. H. Smith, Susan V. Winter-

 fere with the rights of my said husband,

 which my said children may have in said
 property be subjected to the payment of their
 debts to the prejudice of the interest of my said
 husband.

Item 4th

I hereby constitute and appoint
 my said husband W. B. Smith, executor
 of this my last will and testament,
 this Oct. 1st 1891.
