

Last Will of Sarah B. Smith, decd.
State of Georgia, County of Carroll.

Sarah B. Smith of Said State & County, being of Sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last Will and testament, knowing that according to nature, my Soul will soon be called to its Home of rest, and my body return to its mother earth, from whence it came.

Item first.

I give and bequeath & devise to my beloved husband, W. B. Smith, the following property, to-wit:
One hundred acres out of the West half of land lot No. Two Hundred and Sixty One, also Twenty acres out of lot of land No. Two Hundred & Sixty three, as well as appear by reference to a certain deed of Conveyance from Mrs Martha Ann to myself, wherein is a full description of Said land, all of which land is in the Dist. of Said State & Co.

Item 2nd.

I also give, bequeath and devise to my Said husband as above said, all stock and personal property of every description, all of which property, both real and personal, I give to my Said husband, free from all charge whatever to his own proper use, profit and behoof, during his natural life, or so long as he remains unmarried after my death, the same, at the death or marriage of my Said husband to be divided between my children, to-wit: G. B. Smith, Martha J. Kamm, Nancy C. Smith, J. W. Smith, John B. & Smith, W. B. Smith, Susan V. White, & John T. Smith, in such a way that Mrs Martha J. Kamm and Mrs Nancy C. Smith, shall each have ten dollars more than my other children.

Item 3rd.

I also direct that neither of my Said children shall have authority to sell any interest at shall have in any of the above mentioned property, and thereby interfere with the rights of my Said husband,

till after the death or marriage of my Said husband W. B. Smith, nor shall any interest which my Said children may have in Said property be subjected to the payment of their debts to the prejudice of the interest of my Said husband.

Item 4th.

I hereby constitute and appoint my Said husband, W. B. Smith, executor of this my last will and testament,
