of advanced age, and knowing that I must shortly depart
this life, deem it right and proper both as respects
my family and myself that I should make a dis-
position of the property with which a kind Providence
has blessed me, do therefore make this my last will and
testament, hereby revoking all other, hitherto made by me

1st Item I desire and direct that my body be buried
in decent and Christian-like manner, suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life.

2nd Item I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid without delay by my Executors hereinafter
appointed.

3rd Item I give and bequeath to my wife Sophronia E
Scoggin and her children already born unto me, or that
may hereafter be born or be unto me, all my household
and kitchen furniture, also 1/2 of my Horses mules, Cattle
hogs and Sheep, or other animal which I may have on
the farm, at the time of my death together with all my
Wagons buggies or other carriages and vehicles belonging
unto me - Conditioned as follows: That should the said
Sophronia E Scoggin marry again after my decease then
in that event all the foregoing described property (in
(Item 3) be sold and equally divided between the said
Sophronia E Scoggin and the children aforesaid

4th Item I desire and bequeath that the remainder of my
Property be divided equally among all my children
including those by my former wife Martha Scoggin

5th Item And I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
wife Sophronia my Executrix and my son William W
Scoggin my Executor of this my last will and Testament
This the fifth day of May 1873
