Third I give and bequeath unto my son John Newlands  
east half of lot of land number two hundred and thirty  
in the eleventh district of Carroll County with all the  
rights members and appurtenances to said parcel of land  
and any wise belonging to him and his heirs forever

In witness whereof I the said Leahy King do my will consisting of the foregoing have set my hand and seal this the 28th day of February 1872
