Carroll County, Martha & James L. Wilde were present
last Saturday the 11th of September in the year of our
Lord Eighteen hundred & fifty four, at the Residence of Isaac J.
Carroll, before and at the house of his death. Abner Smith, free
house before his death in perfect possession of his mental
faculties he called upon us to precede and take notice of what
he was about to say that it had been his intention to make his
Will in writing and dispose of his property sometime before
but as it was not convenient for him to do so at the time he had
regretted it since he now wishes us to understand that his Will now
desire was that his beloved wife Sarah should have the land that
he now then living as to his children and a portion of fractional part
of lot but now he desires to give them all together as being in the form
of a tract of Carroll County also his negro Hannah Martha
about thirty five years old then and his house hold & to take
possession of all of all kinds with the exception of her own
share of the same and to give her the same.

And Charles & Craywell all of the above mentioned property he
wishes to remain in his wife's possession during her life and in her
last by the Court the property he wishes to be disposed of at Private
Sale by the Court the Records of said Sale together with the
residue of his Estate consisting in part of lands and notes &c
after the payment of all his just debts to be equally divided
among all his children and it was the wish of the deceased
that his beloved Brother Abieliah Craywell should be his
Executor to carry out his Will this 21st September 1804
