

Carroll Co. Will Bk A, 1852-1896

State of Georgia I do the name of God Amen I William Carroll Country Esq Farmer of the County and State aforesaid being sound both in body & mind and knowing the uncertainty of life deem it right and proper both as regards myself and family that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me I therefore make this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me

Item 1<sup>st</sup>

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my condition in life my soul I trust will return to God who gave it

Item 2<sup>d</sup>

I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor herein after appointed

Item 3<sup>d</sup>

I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Lydia E Farmer all my property both real and personal to be used by her for her support and for the Support and Education of my children She having full power to use said property in any way she may think best for the benefit of herself and children whether by selling any part or all said property and buying other property or in any other manner may think best to have as full power to use the same by giving off to the children as they become of age such portion as she may think proper as I myself would have were I living to have and to hold the same during her natural life or widowhood and in Case said wife should marry then and in that Case I desire that all my property be sold and the proceeds be equally divided between my said wife and all my Children share and share alike And in Case my wife should be with Child at my death said Child to have an equal share of my property with my wife and other Children

Item 4<sup>th</sup> At the death of my wife should she die without marrying I desire and direct that all my property be equally divided among my then living children either by lot or by selling the same and dividing the proceeds Item 5<sup>th</sup>

I desire and direct that at my Death my Will be proved before the Court and that afterward my Executor be not required to make any returns to the Court unless she should a marry

I am 6<sup>th</sup> I hereby constitute and appoint my said wife  
 Lydia E Farmer Executrix of this my last Will & Testament  
 In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
 this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1865
