has blessed me. I do therefore make this my
last will and testament - hereby revoking
all others heretofore made by me
And first after my death I desire and
direct that my body be buried in a

decent and christianlike manner my soul I trust
shall return to rest - with God who gave it
2d I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid by my executors hereinafter appointed
3d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Eliza H Taylor all my Land Lot No (72) seven
two in the 6th district of the above state and County
also Lot No (252) two hundred & fifty-two in the 7th
district of the original County and State above men-
tioned. Also all my stock horses hogs cattle and
all other property including all the farming tools all
of which she is to have and control during her nat-
urall life. After her death to be divided between
my heirs to wit - James Taylor Robert F Taylor
Charles B Taylor Rebecca H Mingers Decas H Taylor
John W Taylor Eliza H H Tidwell. And lastly
I hereby constitute and appoint my son
John W Taylor and James L Bastin my exe-
cutors. Signed sealed and acknowledged
before us this twenty seventh day of December
