 follows 50 acres No. (199) in the 11<sup>th</sup> Dist.  
 of said County, 190 acres No 169 in 11<sup>th</sup>  
 Dist. 202 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres No 183 in 11<sup>th</sup> Dist. of  
 said County. I desire that my Executor  
 rent the said lands, the proceeds to go to  
 for the support and education of my minor  
 heirs and should my executor find the proceeds  
 of said lands does not support the minor  
 heirs then he is authorized to sell such  
 portions as will cover said expense  
 3<sup>rd</sup>

I desire that when the youngest  
 heir becomes of age the above mentioned  
 lands be sold and the proceeds equally  
 divided among all the heirs  
 4<sup>th</sup>
