In the name of God I Thomas B Jones of said County and State, being of advanced age, and knowing that I must shortly depart this life, deem it right and proper, both as respects my family and myself, that I should make a disposition of the property with which Providence has blessed me, do therefore make this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

First Item: I desire and direct, that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life. My Soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it, as I hope for eternal salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed, and as I humbly trust enjoyed for forty years.

Second Item: I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid by my Executors hereinafter appointed.

Third Item: I hereby give and devise to my son W. D. Jones Fifty acres more or less of Land - The same being and lying in the North West Corner of Lot Number One hundred & eighty two, to become personally and individually his own at the death of my beloved Wife Sela Jones.

Fourth Item: I give hereby and devise to my Wife Sela Jones all of my property both real and personal, to have and to hold the same for her own use, during her natural life, and at her death, my son W. D. Jones to have and as is hereinbefore directed, and the remainder of property to be equally divided between the balance of my Children.

Fifth Item: I hereby constitute and appoint John D. Jones and William H. Jones Executors of this my last will and Testament, June 1st 1880.
