sound mind memory do make this my last will and tes-
tament in manner and form (that is to say) I desire my
body my body be buried in a plain and decent manner
with as little expense as possible at the discretion of my fam-
ily and Executor

First of all I desire my farm be sold at
public sale to the highest bidder also all my household and
kitchen furniture. Stock of hogs and cattle, horse or horses if any
buggy wagon and all other effects belonging to my estate. That
I further declare it to be my will after paying all my just
& lawful debts. That there is a debt I owe my oldest son by
my first wife William John Hollingsworth Timmons amounting
to fifty dollars. There is no note for it, exist simply between us
two which debt I declare to be just and true and I hereby or-
dain that my Executor pay that debt. And I further ordain
that after the sale of all my effects and the net amount is
fully known and such arrangements as is thought necessary
by the legates for the support of Mary Butler Timmons my wife
that my oldest son by my first wife to wit Wm J & C Timmons
receive Ten dollars of all the net proceeds of my estate &
life insurance and that my five sons by wife Mary B. viz
Robert Abijah Timmons Thomas Holmes Timmons Hannibal
Cato Timmons Benson Ellissdane Timmons and Doctor Floyd
Clarke Timmons. All receive an equal Portion in my estate
with their mother Mary Butler Timmons. I do hereby constitute
and appoint my son Robert Abijah Timmons Executor
of this my last will and testament. And that he receive
no compensation for his services only my old silver watch
and he keep it as a relic of his deceased father, And I do
sincerely declare & revoke all other wills but this
