 District of Carroll County being one hundred and fifty three
 more or less on the west side of Lot 34 one hundred and fifty
 five (165) in the plan of said district during her natural
 life and also all my stock of all kinds horse and kitchen
 furniture and all the residue of my effects whatever likewise
 I make I make constitute and appoint my worthy friend
 P H Gillespie to be my executor of this my last will and testam-
 ent hereby revoking all former wills by me made in witness
 whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and fixed my seal
 this the 21st day of August 1863 Thomas J Warren
