and transitory life, do therefore make, ordain, publish
and declare this to be my last will and testament
that is to say, First after all my lawful debts are
paid and discharged, The residue of my estate, real
and personal, I give, bequeath and dispose of as
follows to wit

To my beloved wife the land whereon I
now live in. Known by No one Hundred and
fifty five, one hundred Acres; and fifty acres
less to one hundred Sixty Six, both in the Columbus
District of Carroll County, Georgia; All farming tools
and all produce on hand at my decease, and my
Horse, one, Cow and Calf, and one hen and eight
and my bed and bedstead and bed clothing and
a truss which she may choose, all this to remain
my own property, as long as she remains a Widow
but if she marries again, all to be sold and
equally divided between my lawful heirs except
what she had and was possessed of when we were
married, and my Will is that all she had and was
possessed of when we were married to be her own
right and property, and to do as she pleases with it,
and all that I will to her, at her decease to be sold
and equally divided between my lawful heirs
share and share alike. Likewise I make, constitute
and appoint my worthy friend Elisha Gentry
to be the executor of this my last Will and Testament
touching revoking all former Will by me made
