3^d It- I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Mariah all of my property both real and personal to have and to hold for her own benefit during her lifetime

4th It- After the death of my wife as aforesaid I desire and direct that my property shall be equally divided between my children or their heirs in case of the death of any of them

5th It- I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved son F M Camp Executor of this my last will and testament- This September 3^d 1871
